Look alikes: *Gyromitra esculenta* (left), *Verpa bohemica* (right), *Gyromitra gigas* (center)

No longer recommended

Look-alikes: Angel Wing *Pleurotus porrigens* (right, not recommended) and Oyster mushrooms *Pleurotus ostreatus*, *P. Populinus* (on left)





Look-alikes: *Agaricus xanthodermus* (poisonous for some, left),
Agaricus californicus (mildly poisonous, right)



Look-alikes: Jack-o-Lanterns (poisonous, pictured) and honey mushrooms or chanterelles.
